NAME

TOGAF[®] Business Architecture Level 1

DESCRIPTION

Individuals who have earned this credential have knowledge and understanding of Business Modeling, Business Capabilities, Business Scenarios, Information Mapping, and Value Streams and how to apply them in development of a Business Architecture based on the TOGAF Standard, Version 9.2.

CREDENTIAL CRITERIA

Individuals who have earned this credential understand:

- The topic of business modeling and how it relates to Enterprise Architecture within a TOGAF context
- The concept of business capabilities and how business capabilities can be modeled
- Value streams and value stream mapping
- Information mapping
- How to apply the TOGAF Business Scenario method
- How a Business Architecture can be developed with the TOGAF ADM

APPLICATION PREREQUISITES

None.

EDUCATION EXPERIENCE

The path to achieve this credential is to complete the Learning Units defined in the Conformance Requirements Document and a pass result for the Indicator of Compliance.

INDICATOR OF COMPLIANCE

Candidates are required to pass the TOGAF Business Architecture Part 1 examination. The examination consists of 30 questions in simple multiple-choice format with a 60% pass mark (18/30).

DURATION

The duration of this credential is indefinite – this credential is to a given version of the Body of Knowledge and does not expire, so there are no renewal requirements.

STANDARDS

The TOGAF Standard, Version 9.2 (Doc. No. C182)

RECOMMENDATIONS

Individuals who have earned this credential are recommended to consider the TOGAF Business Architecture Level 2 credential (when available) and other additional credentials related to the TOGAF Library.
